

## **KEY RECOMMENDATIONS FROM ASM HORWATH REVIEW OF THEME 1.1: AID FOR PEACE REPORTS**

### **Peace-building needs analysis**

Should

- be updated to reflect all new research and identify any ongoing knowledge gaps
- provide a robust assessment of what the significant needs are for the Cluster area, including prioritising the needs identified.

### **Peace-building relevance assessment**

Should link

- strategic objectives of the Plan with the needs identified
- indicative activities for the Plan with the Individual Change Theory and the Healthy Relationships and Connections Theory.

### **Conflict risk assessment**

Should include

- a robust list of peace and reconciliation risks
- mitigating actions
- assessment of likelihood
- reporting frequency
- identification of a Senior Responsible Officer

### **Peace-building effects assessment**

Should

- focus on a smaller number of more strategic SMART indicators (must include a delivery date)
- Provide descriptions of the proposed evaluation mechanisms and performance monitoring framework
